Noteworthy News

- Austin, Texas pro-lifers are rejoicing over a federal district court ruling reversing a 2012 City Council ordinance favoring abortion providers. This ordinance required pregnancy resource centers that do not offer or refer for abortions to post signs announcing this fact. The ability to speak with abortion-minded women has saved so many lives. Many seeking abortion are unaware of the resources available to them and when they learn of the support available, they choose life for their children. Congratulations, Austin!
- ▼ The King's Men Catholic Apostolate offers the Samson Retreat, a healing outreach for men seeking purpose in their pain. Whether it is pornography, abortion, bullying, divorce, or countless other normalized forms of trauma and abuse, the human person made in the image and likeness of God yearns for a healing encounter with Christ the Divine Physician. Offering the Sacramental Life of the Church amidst a supportive brotherhood, the Samson Retreat aims to be a vehicle driving this necessary healing encounter. - ▶ LifeNews.com reports that in a unanimous decision on June 26, 2014, the Supreme Court struck down a Massachusetts buffer zone law prohibiting pro-life free speech outside abortion clinics. The decision is a huge victory for pro-life sidewalk counselors who provide women with abortion alternatives. The decision strikes down a Massachusetts law that created a 35-foot "buffer zone" restricting pro-life advocates from speaking with people entering abortion facilities. Praise God!

Memorial Crosses

A special way to remember the lives of the 56 million children who have lost their lives through the tragedy of abortion is the Memorial Cross display at local churches. The display consists of 56 small white crosses and a sign indicating that each cross represents one million abortions in our country since the 1973 *Roe v. Wade* ruling. We have encountered many positive reactions to the



crosses. Women who are mourning the loss of their own children have left flowers at the displays and one young man said that after seeing them, he and his girlfriend changed their minds about aborting their baby. The Pro-Life Union will deliver the crosses to a church, install and then pick them up. They remain at a church for approximately one month. Please consider asking your pastor to host the crosses at your church. They are a very powerful image and an education tool for passersby.

Save the Date!

It may seem early to start planning for our annual *Stand Up For Life Dinner*, but it will be here before we know it! This year's Dinner will be held on Sunday, November 23rd at the Philadelphia Sheraton. Our guest speaker will be Ryan Bomberger. Ryan's biological mother was raped, yet courageously chose to continue her pregnancy, giving him life. He was adopted as a baby and was raised in a loving, Christian family of 15, with siblings of varying ethnicities. Ryan founded the Radiance Foundation, which brings to light the staggering rate of abortion in the Black community, as well as the subject of adoption. The Dinner gives us a chance to gather with pro-lifers for a night of fellowship and fun. Ticket prices are \$60 per person. A table of ten will be discounted to \$550. Student tickets are just \$40.
