Stories from the Sidewalk

The hustle and bustle of Center City is the background to quiet conversations about life and choices whenever we engage in sidewalk counseling. Most women happily take the cards explaining fetal development and many are open to talking with us for a few minutes. Women share their reasons for visiting and most are unaware that over 5,000 abortions are performed at Planned Parenthood in Center City each year. Inevitably, they grimace when we share this truth. One young woman shared the problems caused by the birth control she had been using, which included panic attacks and depression. She welled up as we confirmed that others experienced the same side effects. Planned Parenthood promises easy access to birth control and abortion. They sell sex without commitment and convince too many that there won't be any side effects. But, when we listen to the experiences of many women, another story is told - one of regret and pain. And, so we pray and we witness and listen, trusting that by doing so, their lives and ours, can be transformed.

On May 29th, Marty Moss-Coane at RadioTimes invited the Pro-Life Union to join a segment which discussed a new book about abortion doctors. The Pro-Life Union joined the conversation to share the truth about our commitment to reaching women as they enter abortion facilities. We believe that through a loving witness those working in the abortion industry can and will changed by God's grace.

The Man with the Golden Arm



Some pregnant moms are affected by a very serious condition known as rhesus isoimmunization, or RH Disease. It occurs when the mother has an RH negative blood type and the baby is RH positive. This condition has caused heartbreak to so many, as it can cause miscarriage.

Enter James Harrison. This 78 year old Australian has a rare blood type that enabled doctors to develop the Anti-D injection, which can protect babies from this affliction. When James was age 14, he required major surgery and had to receive almost two gallons of donated blood. He vowed at that time that he would return the favor and began giving blood as soon as he could at the age of 18. For the past 60 years, James has donated blood plasma, which has been used to save an estimate 2 million babies' lives! He is known as the "Man with the golden arm," but we think of him as the "Man with the golden heart," saving each of these precious pre-born babies.

Thanks to Abington Friends High School for inviting us to speak with the juniors and seniors this past April about the politics of abortion. The class challenged us with great questions and we are grateful for the opportunity to share the message of dignity of each person with the students!

The Pro-Life Union participated in the EWTN nightly news show with Susanne LaFrankie on the impact of the Gosnell case and why it is critical to strictly enforce all legislation regarding abortion. The segment was filmed at Gosnell's former facility, which remains closed.
