For many years, the Pro-Life Union organized prayer and witness at the Women’s Medical Clinic, owned by Kermit Gosnell. Every second Saturday, a faithful group would pray from 9-10 am and reach out to women as they walked in to the clinic. It was always strangely quiet on Saturday mornings, and it was only after the arrest of Gosnell that we learned that he was offering abortions at odd hours, well past legal limits and in a filthy clinic. It is still strange to walk past the former clinic. The entry way is a mess and the sign still sits in the window.

So, it was with great joy that we visited the new location of Alpha Care, located next to the former clinic. Alpha is a member organization of the Pro-Life Union and they serve families by providing pregnancy tests, counseling, ultrasounds and support. Alpha moved its office to Lancaster Avenue and now shares a wall with the former Gosnell clinic. The opening of Alpha on Lancaster Avenue is truly an answer to the heartfelt prayers that the Gosnell facility would close. It is incredibly amazing to see a light shine in the darkness.

One Hour

In the middle of Forty Days for Life we were given an amazing gift – a snowstorm! Sure, the snow that fell was not entirely welcomed by most of us and it took us by surprise. Yet, on that day, the abortion facilities throughout our area were closed. That means no children lost their lives to abortion! Women were given another chance to think about their pregnancy.

By the time this Update reaches you, the spring 40 Days for Life Campaign will be almost complete. What an incredible gift this outreach has been for the country and for Philadelphia. The two busiest abortion companies in our City were stationed with a loving, faithful presence every day of the Campaign. The stories of conversations and discussions with women and people in the community are powerful. God’s grace has inspired so many to commit to an hour or more. Abortion in PA 2015

The following facts were pulled from the state released report on abortion statistics for Pennsylvania for 2015. The numbers give insight into the abortion industry. Eighty seven percent of women having an abortion are unmarried, they lack support and feel alienated and alone. Abortion is viewed as the answer. Division is sowed among the couple. We see and hear this reality from the women and men we meet at abortion facilities. Pray for conversion and for unity among couples. Pray that they see the life created as a gift!

The Black population in Pennsylvania is just 10.5%, yet over 41% of abortions were performed on Black mothers.

- 87% (27,923) abortions were performed on unmarried women

Talking Points

Planned Parenthood is on the defense as calls for defunding the abortion giant continue. Actual medical services at PP continue to decrease while abortion remains a cornerstone of their business. Breast cancer screenings, PAP tests, and HPV treatments have all fallen significantly at PP facilities. Planned Parenthood responded to President Trump’s offer to continue funding their organization on the condition they stop performing abortions. The response, “Planned Parenthood is proud to provide abortion...” speaks for itself. Abortion is Planned Parenthood’s brand. And, no matter what, they will defend and provide abortions. One last point - Cecile Richard’s income last year was \$957, 952.

Celebrating at the Parade


