

Mother's Day Vigil and Rally at Philadelphia Women's Center

On Saturday of Mother's Day weekend, forty socially-distanced, face-masked defenders of life gathered to stand up for life at the Philadelphia Women's Center, the worst abortion center in PA. This facility ends the lives of more than 6,500 babies annually. Pro-Life Union is the *Amicus Curiae* for Important Freedom of Speech Case

Our friends at the Independence Law Center named the Pro-Life Union of Greater Philadelphia as the *Amicus Curie* in a Friend of the Court brief for an important case. Pittsburgh enacted a law that bans speech and advocacy—even prayer—in painted zones outside medical facility entrances. The city then chose to paint such zones outside only two facilities in the entire metropolitan area, Pittsburgh's two abortion clinics, and enforced the ban against pro-life speech only.
